Origami is the traditional Japanese art of paper folding. Using just a single piece of square paper, we can create fantastic paper art.

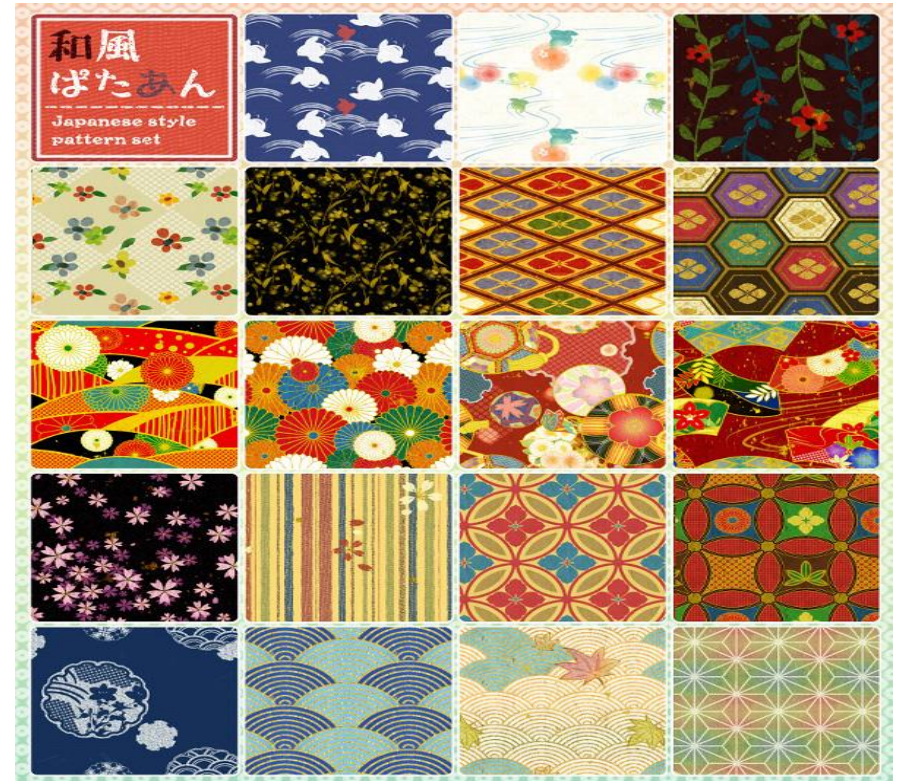
